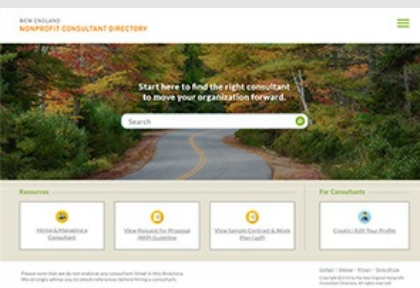


3,400 Nonprofit Leaders Respond to Nonprofit Finance Fund's 2018 State of the Sector Survey
