- Accounting software
- Internal controls

Once the review has been completed, your organization may then apply for a Financial Management Grant to implement the priority recommendations, such as:

- > Hiring finance staff or outsourcing the finance function
- Engaging a consultant to assist with implementation of projects
- Purchasing accounting software and related hardware
- Providing training to staff or board on financial topics

Continuation funding may also be available to sustain any financial staffing hired.
