Candid resources can be used at any Hartford Public Library (HPL) location without a library card

Foundation Directory

- Information on grant giving organizations to help nonprofits find the right funders
- Use the Advanced Search & Filters option to see the most relevant results

The Candid website (candid.org) has free video trainings. Once on the website click on the button labeled Nonprofit training.

If you are a Hartford resident, get a library card to use the following resources anywhere there is an Internet connection

- **Legal Information Source:** Legal content for non-lawyers. Search for the phrase “nonprofit” to see related information.
- **Business Collection--ABI/INFORM:** Articles from noted business journals. Use for background information on nonprofits and other topics related to your organization.
 - *The previous two resources can be accessed without a HPL card at any HPL location.*
- **Universal Class:** Contains self-paced courses on a variety of topics including “How to Write a Grant Proposal” and other Accounting and Business courses.
 - *Note--Must have a HPL card to use regardless of location.*
